SEASONAL GARDENING TIPS:

As summer heat moderates, fall is a great planting season for trees and shrubs. Observe the three 'Rs': right plant, right place & the right time.

These are small chores that should be done to help plants survive the winter and make your property more beautiful in the spring!

SEPT: Continue regular watering of trees and shrubs up to ground freeze up. It is time to plant spring flowering bulbs.

OCT: Divide, transplant and cut your perennials back to the ground after they have finished flowering. Be sure to water them in! Leave ornamental grasses long so they can add winter interest to your yard by catching the frost, snow and frigid breezes. Clean up beds, replenish mulch and fertilize your lawn.

NOV: Prune shade trees and summer flowering shrubs. And don't forget our feathered friends... keep bird feeders stocked. Wilt proof or burlap broadleaf evergreens to prevent winter burn. Winterize gas powered equipment.

A: If deer are hungry enough, they will eat anything. One way you can deter them is to plant deer resistant plant material. This will sometimes help!
